**Literacy Connections** is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization founded in 1975 as Literacy Volunteers of America-Dutchess County, Inc. We later changed our name to Literacy Connections of the Hudson Valley, Inc. We serve adult students with the lowest literacy levels and immigrants lacking English language skills in Dutchess, Columbia, Greene and Orange Counties. Recognizing that illiteracy or low literacy is a family issue, our Adult and Family Literacy program also offers reading enrichment to children through our Book Buddies program, which brings volunteers to read to children in schools who are reading below grade level.

Our core program is to help adults learn to read and write and function independently by recruiting and training volunteers to provide one-to-one and small group tutoring that is student-centered. Student-centered means not following a pre-determined curriculum and giving a voice to the student with regard to their learning goals. Teaching adults is not the same as teaching children. Materials must be sensitive and respectful of adult learners, and because adults face so many challenges in their daily lives, the learning must be relevant and meaningful.

Literacy Connections is the only organization providing basic literacy education and English Language skills to adults with the lowest literacy levels in Dutchess, Columbia, Greene, and Orange counties. These adults are often not eligible for other educational or vocational opportunities due to the lack of basic literacy or English Language skills.

Literacy Connections programs are funded by the New York State Education Department, The Dyson Foundation, Dollar General Family Literacy, Dutchess County Partnership Grant, United Way of the Dutchess-Orange Region, other foundations, businesses, and the generous donations of contributors like you.


Funds raised through this event will help more adults in our Community improve their reading, writing, and English language skills, and children struggling with reading will receive the help needed to become confident, grade-level readers.
